

### The 75th Vineyard Race

On Friday, September 4, 2009, SYC held the 75th anniversary of its classic Vineyard Race — one of the premiere yachting events on the East Coast. Challenging yet family-friendly, the annual Labor Day race is a 238-mile long distance course across Long Island Sound, past Block Island, around Martha's Vineyard and back.
